### EARLY HEAD START (Home Base or Center)

Home Base serves pregnant women & infants/ toddlers,  
birth to three years of age in a Home Setting  
Center Based serves toddlers 18-30 months old

### HEAD START

Children must be 3 or 4 years old by September 1, 2015  
to be served in a center based setting

#### Important!

If you are receiving TANF benefits (child care certificate, cash assistance, or transportation assistance), SSI, or homeless, you ARE eligible for Head Start, even if your income exceeds the guidelines.
